## DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR A LOWELL G. ARMSTRONG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Any graduating senior who is a current member of the Greater Anchorage USBC Association Youth wishing to apply for a scholarship award should prepare a folder containing a letter of application, a sealed transcript of grades and three letters of recommendation. Please prepare the application folder carefully, as the Greater Anchorage USBC Scholarship Committee will review it. These folders should be submitted as indicated on the attached cover sheet.

Specific items to be included in your folder are:

- 1. Letter of application which should include the following:
  - a. Personal history information about your family, yourself, where you have lived, what you like to do, your future plans, etc.
  - b. Memberships in any organizations in or outside of school. Include any Greater Anchorage USBC Youth offices held or any honors accorded you.
  - c. An essay of at least 250 words that address your future plans for your education. Why you wish to go to college, or trade school and your major fields of interest.
- 2. A recent photograph of yourself.
- 3. A sealed transcript of credits which should be requested from your school registrar's office.
- 4. Three letters of recommendation. Suggested sources are as follows; faculty members, person for whom you have worked for, person of your choice.

- 6. In addition, you may wish to include newspaper articles and other material concerning honors and activities you have participated in during recent years.
- 7. Give the Coach's evaluation and data sheet to a bowling coach, ask that they complete and return it to you for submission with your folder.
- 8. Must have a 2.0 Grade point average to be considered for a Greater Anchorage USBC Scholarship award.
- 9. If you meet the minimum requirements you will be requested to attend a formal interview with the scholarship committee. Appropriate dress is required.
