The Tournament format consists of four games bowled across seven pairs of lanes in two divisions. The number of bowlers in each division is cut to half after the first four games and those who make the top half bowl an additional four games. The top five bowers in each division then compete in a step ladder roll-off to determine the monthly winners for each division.

Monthly Scholarships awarded in each division for the 2018/2019 season will be \$150.00 for 1st place, \$125.00 for 2nd place, \$100.00 for 3rd place, \$75.00 for 4th place and \$50.00 for 5th place.

The five individuals in each Division who make the stepladder become eligible to compete in the TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS in April providing they participate in at least six Tournaments during the 2018/2019 season. Additionally, bowlers participating in **EVERY** tournament (all eight regular tournaments) during the season will receive a Perfect Attendance Scholarship in April.

Scholarships are deposited into the USBC Smart account and must be claimed by contacting USBC
